

Eligible Training Provider List (ETPL) Policy: Summary of Changes

- 1.) New partnership between Colorado Department of Labor (CDLE) and the Colorado Department of Higher Education (CDHE).
- 2.) Established to ensure the accountability, quality, and labor-market relevance of training programs eligible to receive WIOA funds.
- 3.) Two, new and separate websites:
 - a. Training Providers: www.coloradoetpl.org
 - b. Students: www.cotrainingproviders.org
- 4.) CDLE will ensure that training providers are in compliance with CDHE by verifying that the training provider is licensed, certified or authorized by the appropriate oversight agency to operate in Colorado. Authorization by the appropriate oversight agency is required prior to being eligible for inclusion on Colorado's ETPL.
- 5.) Training providers are now required to provide social security numbers for all students residing in Colorado, regardless of funding source. These numbers are matched with Colorado wage data and will be used to calculate performance measures.
- 6.) Although Registered Apprenticeships must be on Colorado's ETPL to be supported by WIOA Adult/Dislocated Worker funds, they are automatically eligible and included on the ETPL, and are exempt from the performance reporting requirements. Registered Apprenticeships will be included on the ETPL until they lose their registration or they indicate they do not wish to be included.
