Veterans Corner

The LCWC offers veterans and eligible spouses priority of service for all qualified job and training programs.

Veterans and eligible spouses, including widows and widowers as defined in the statute and regulations, are eligible to receive priority of service for the receipt of employment, training, and placement services that are directly funded by the U.S. Department of Labor (USDOL). Priority of service means that veterans and eligible spouses are entitled to precedence over non-covered persons for USDOL-funded job training programs administered by the LCWC. A veteran or an eligible spouse will receive access to a service earlier in time than a non-covered person or, if the resource is limited, the veteran or eligible spouse receives access to the services instead of or before the non-covered person. Unemployment Insurance (UI) Corner

On **December 11th, 2017**, the UI Office changed the process for customers filing claims by phone. The phone line will only be available to customers who have barriers to filing online claims. Barriers include not having reliable computer access, complex claims, disability barriers, etc. If a customer contacts the UI Customer Service line and does not have a barrier to filing their claim, the customer will be asked to file their claim online and the call will disconnect. **If you need access to a computer to file your claim**, please visit one of the LCWC locations at 200 W. Oak St., Fort Collins or 418 E. 4th St., Loveland.
