## Veterans Corner

The new VA Clinic in Loveland is open!

The Cheyenne VA Medical Center has expanded their programs into the Loveland community with a 23,000 square-foot facility to further serve veterans in Northern Colorado. The Loveland VA Clinic, also known as the Loveland Community Outpatient Clinic, is located at 5200 Hahns Peak Dr., Loveland, CO.

The clinic has a Patient Aligned Care Team (PACT) offering Primary Care, Mental Health, Pharmacy, Social Work, and Nutrition services. Additional services include: Specialty Mental Health, Optometry/Ophthalmology, Physical and Occupational Therapy, Podiatry, Cardiopulmonary, Telehealth, Hub for Home Based Primary Care, Laboratory and Pathology, Audiology, Veteran Transportation Services, Chaplain, Police, and Veterans Experience Liaison.

## Training and Internship Resources

Have you experienced a layoff and are eligible for Unemployment Insurance (UI) benefits?

The Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) offers intensive services to eligible job seekers who desire to enhance their skills and add experience to their resumes. The LCWC Career Transition and Training (CTT) team offers the WIOA grant in the form of career planning, intensive job search support, scholarship assistance for training, and work-based learning.



A training scholarship can provide up to \$4000 for tuition, books, and fees to help prepare eligible candidates for occupations that are growing in Northern Colorado.

A work-based learning opportunity can provide eligible candidates a

connection to local employers while enhancing their workplace skills and adding recent work experience to their resumes. The CTT team currently supports work-based learning opportunities in the form of paid internships, On-the-Job Training (OJT) opportunities, and apprenticeships.
