## Larimer County Workforce Center Sector Partnership

**The Larimer County Workforce Center is actively working to support industry businesses and sector partnerships in the areas of**

### **Healthcare | Manufacturing | Transportation | Information Technology**

In addition to participating in current partnership activities, the Workforce Center also has funding available to support individual businesses in meeting their workforce needs. Specifically we offer:

- ❖ Grants to eligible job seekers for skills training supporting in-demand occupations to help develop a pipeline of qualified candidates for industry. We continually gather data about current and future demand to guide our focus. To ensure that our efforts meet the needs of the industry, we welcome the valued input of individual businesses and seek partnerships to this end.
- ❖ Funds to support job seekers in work-based learning opportunities such as internships. Internships provide businesses the chance to see a candidate in action and may serve as an on-the-job interview while providing job seekers with valuable, hands-on experience.
- ❖ Funds to support businesses who directly hire candidates that are a great fit for the organization but who may have a small skills gap. Businesses who hire eligible candidates may be reimbursed a percentage of the candidate's salary for a period of time to help offset the cost of training by the company, ensuring great candidates don't go unutilized.

Eligibility for funding is connected to the job seeker/candidate and includes:

- Colorado resident that has been laid off from employment, due to no fault of their own, and is/was eligible for Unemployment Insurance benefits within the past 5 years.

Additionally our Business Services team has a variety of services available to aid in the entire employment cycle, including support in the areas of Recruitment and Selection, internal Training and Development to increase retention, and Workforce Planning.
