Looking for volunteers to pre-test a survey

Mathematica Policy Research is recruiting volunteers to help test two surveys for an employment study. We will be asking questions about your current and past employment, how you approach looking for jobs, and any job assistance you may have received. This is just a test and none of the data will be used, however the feedback you provide will be used to improve the surveys.

We would like to test two surveys over the phone with volunteers.

- The first survey will take between 30-40 minutes. Volunteers will receive a **\$10 VISA card**.
- The second survey will take between 1 and 1.5 hours. Volunteers will receive a **\$25 VISA card**.
- If you can test both surveys, it will take around 2 hours. Volunteers will receive a **\$35 VISA card**.
